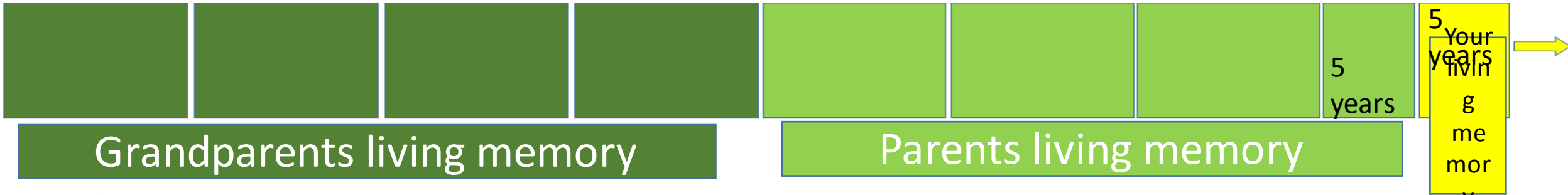


Year 1 Knowledge Organiser – Through the Keyhole (Houses and Homes)
